Twenty Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

People undergoing counselling and
therapy sometimes have a block or
memory, which is holding them back,
often an earlier difficult experience of
some kind. Something like that is
happening in the Old Testament fold tale of the bronze
serpent. The power of the serpent to cause harm is
taken away once they are confronted straight in the eye,
through the symbol of the bronze serpent. We may say
the same of Jesus as he faced death for us. Being lifted
up for our sake, he looked death in the eye and took
away its power over us.
