**More Than a Symbol: Meeting Christ in the Eucharist**

At every Mass, we hear familiar words: “This is my Body This is my Blood.” Because we hear them so often, it can be easy to lose sight of the extraordinary reality they proclaim. The Catholic Church teaches that the Eucharist is not merely a symbol or a reminder of Jesus. Through the power of the Holy Spirit and Christ’s own promise, the bread and wine truly become His Body and Blood. This is the Real Presence of Christ among us.

When we come forward to receive Holy Communion, we are not receiving a sacred object or participating in a religious ritual alone. We are receiving Jesus Himself—alive, risen, and present. The same Lord who walked the roads of Galilee, who died on the Cross and rose from the tomb, comes to us in the Eucharist.

This is also why the Blessed Sacrament is reserved in the tabernacle. Christ remains present among His people, inviting us to prayer, adoration, and friendship. The red sanctuary lamp reminds us that He is here.

For regular Mass-goers, this can be both reassuring and challenging. If we truly believe Jesus is present, how might it deepen our reverence, our prayer, and our love? The Eucharist is not simply something we receive; it is Someone who receives us and transforms us.
