ANNIVERSARY MASSES: booked for next few weeks will now not go ahead publicly, they can be viewed online or rescheduled for a later date.

FUNERALS: The recommendation is that only immediate family and close friends would attend the funeral liturgy. A thoughtful card or note expressing sympathy might be effective in expressing our solidarity with the bereaved.

WEDDINGS: The recommendation is that no gathering of more than 25 persons take place for weddings. Wedding guests should be limited to the Bridal Party and immediate family. Guests are asked to observe the hygiene protocols and observe social distance while in Church.

FACE COVERINGS: The Diocese of Killaloe now ‘strongly recommends’ the wearing of face coverings in addition to social distancing and sanitising of hands in all its Churches and buildings when attending public Masses and services.
