FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT -- "Year A" 29th March 2020

Public Celebration of Mass

In View of the Government Statement and the need to avoid indoor public gatherings of more than 100 people, and the difficulty of guaranteeing this in practice, following consultation I have decided as follows:

- All public Masses in this diocese, Sundays and weekdays (with the exception of Funeral Masses and the Celebration of Marriage see below) are suspended until 19th April or until further notice.
- The obligation to be physically present at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days is therefore suspended for every-body until further notice.
- Priests will continue to remember the needs of parishioners at Mass celebrated privately.
- The faithful are encouraged to join spiritually in the celebration of Mass, either on parish radio or on webcam. Parishes that have web-cams include: Kilrush, Roscrea, Ennis, Quin, Nenagh and Shannon.

Parishioners are also encouraged to pray at home, including especially prayers for the sick, for those who are caring

<u>CLOCKS GO FORWARD THIS WEEKEND</u>! Don't forget that, with the onset of Summer time, clocks will go forward on Sunday March 29th at 1.00am.

FIRST FRIDAY: Friday next is the First Friday in April. On the basis of the public health guidelines, First Friday house visits and other pastoral house visits should cease except in the cases of the anointing of those who are seriously or gravely ill **GROUPED ANNIVERSARY MASSES:** booked for next month will not now go ahead and can be rescheduled for a later date. **BAPTISMS:** Following on from Tuesdays Government announcement limiting social gatherings to a maximum of four people - Except in the case of danger of death Baptisms should be postponed until further notice.

<u>FUNERALS</u>: The recommendation is that only immediate family and close friends would attend the funeral liturgy. A thoughtful card or note expressing sympathy might be effective in expressing our solidarity with the bereaved.

WEDDINGS: The recommendation is that no gathering of more than 100 persons take place indoors. Wedding guests should be limited to the Bridal Party and immediate family. Guests are asked to observe the hygiene protocols and observe social distance while in Church.
