RE-OPENING OF OUR THREE CHURCHES: From Monday 10th May, 2021 it is possible to have congregations at all Masses. There is a limit of 50 people in each church with the exception of very large churches where a number of pods of people not exceeding 50 can be created as long as they remain separate from each other. The precautions that were established between June and December last year will remain in place and Mass goers are asked to co-operate with social distance hand sanitisation wearing of face coverings people for the same households to sit in the same seat, remain seated during mass to minimise movement. People may also attend Mass by sitting in their cars outside churches Holy Communion will be distributed.

Baptisms - Bookings are now being taken for Baptisms. A maximum of 10 people can attend the ceremony. To arrange a Baptism please contact the Parish Office.

Funerals - up to 50 mourners can attend a Funeral Mass.

Weddings - A maximum of 50 people can attend the celebration of Marriage in the Church.

First Holy Communions and Confirmations—Current Government advice is that these ceremonies should not take place in May and June. Further advice will follow on resumption of these ceremonies when it is safe to do so.

ANNIVERSARY MASSES: Group Anniversary Mass will not take place for the time being. Anniversary Masses can now be booked for any scheduled weekday or weekend mass by contacting the parish office. One intention per mass.
