**COP26**

The 26th UN Climate Conference (or COP26 for short) begins today in Glasgow and will go on until Nov 12<sup>th</sup>. The conference addresses strategies related climate change, global warming etc. There is a proposal to put measures in place to limit any increase in global temperature to 1.5°C. Measures to be considered will have implications for all aspects of life from farming to housing, travel and more.

Pope Francis, along with other religious leaders has called on those attending COP26 to renew their commitment to keep global temperatures below 1.5°C and to take action to make this possible. **"We have inherited a garden: we must not leave a desert to our children,"** the statement says. We are asked to pray for the success of COP26 during these days.
