RE-OPENING OF OUR THREE CHURCHES: There is a limit of 50 people in each church with the exception of very large churches where a number of pods of people not exceeding 50 can be created as long as they remain separate from each other. The following precautions still remain in place and Mass goers are asked to co-operate with:

- **remain seated during mass to minimise movement.**
