<u>Amen</u>

Amen is a short, to-the-point word. It is a strong word, a word of commitment, a type of vow. "This I believe. This is where I stand. This is who I am." We often speak the word in a whisper or a mumble, but that doesn't take away from its meaning and power. We should, perhaps, belt it out loudly with plenty of gusto. There is a place in the Mass called the Great Amen. The priest brings the Eucharistic prayer to a conclusion with a powerful affirmation of what has just happened and an exclamation of glory and praise to the Trinity "Through him and with him and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit all glory and honour is yours Almighty Father, forever and ever" he then stops and the congregation respond with an exuberant "Amen" that signifies our recognition of the consecration that has occurred. Face to face with the awesome reality of God, there is no way for us to understand it. So we simply exclaim, "Amen." During mass the priest offers many prayers ending with very familiar phrases like "forever and ever" or "through Christ out Lord" which act as a springboard to launch us to respond "Amen". Even if the priest invites you to join him in the prayer, don't let that most important Amen get lost. It may be a short word, but it expresses something that is beyond words, something divine. Amen to that!
