Refurbishment of the Parochial House

Work on the refurbishment and restoration of the parochial house in Kilmaley has begun in the past week. This is an old and historic stone building. Perhaps some local historian knows its history and when exactly it was built and they might let us know. The records show that alongside parish priests, 54 curates served in the parish since 1835. I presume many of them lived in this house.

Like all buildings of its age it needs regular refurbishment which has been done over the years by excellent local craftsmen, the most extensive refurbishment took place during Fr Hillery's time here over 30 years ago.

Over the years the soak-pits to take rain and waste water in the heavy 'Dóib bhuí' soil have silted up, raising the water level, and causing significant water damage due to rising damp in the house. Works will include upgrading drainage, waste water and sewerage, replacing rotten and water-damaged timbers and plasterboard, improving insulation and moving the parish office to a more suitable location within the house. The parish property and finance committee have done an excellent job enlisting local craftsmen to complete the work by direct labour and ensuring materials are sourced at the best price as we go on. This means a significant saving to the parish despite current inflation in the construction sector and ensures the best value for parish funds.

We hope to have the job finished and Fr John moved into the parish by Christmas. This essential work will protect the structure of the house into the future and preserve it as a valuable asset to the parish and we thank all of you, whose support has made it possible.
