OPENING OF CHURCHES: Most people are aware that from this Monday, May 10th it will be possible to have congregations at our weekday and weekend Masses. There is a limit of 50 people in each church with the exception of very large churches where a number of pods of people not exceed 50 can be created as long as they remain separate from each other. The precautions that were established between June and December last year will apply and all Mass goers are requested to co-operate with the procedures put in place at that time in our parish. People may also attend Mass by sitting in their cars outside the church and Holy Communion will be distributed to them.
