The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

The Catholic Church has consistently taught that during celebration of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, the bread and wine are truly changed into the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. This is what is meant by

the "True Presence" or "Real Presence" of Jesus in the Most Holy Eucharist. Although the elements still have the appearance of bread and wine, they have - through the power of the Holy Spirit - actually changed into Jesus' Body and Blood, just as they did at the Last Supper.

The Second Vatican Council referred to the Eucharist as "the source and summit" of our faith and it is therefore deserving of our worship, love and deepest respect.

This feast of Corpus Christi, established by Pope Urban IV in 1264, celebrates the miracle of the Eucharist. When we share in the Eucharist, we share in Jesus' miraculous love for us and for all sinners. In the Most Holy Eucharist, we truly receive Jesus - his Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity - nourishing us for those lonely moments that are so often part of our human experience, and reassuring us that God is always present in our lives.
