Notes:

- 1 In 2022 there are one-off costs for maintenance and repairs of the parish office.
- 2 Some one-off refrub costs for the house which we reported last year, went through early in 2022
- 3 Insurance costs did not decrease we are just paying it in installments vs one lump sum
- 4 Priest Collection not covering priest salary loss of €8,750. We are also attempting to resolve significant accrued losses on this account. Having one of the two priests now paid directly by the diocese eases the burden slightly.
- **5** In 2021 the Diocese repaid a €20,000 which the parish had made a number of years ago.
- **6** What appears to be a loss of €1963 on shrine candles arises because the candle money was included with the loose change in the baskets and not recorded separately.
