There is a core similarity between the four accounts of the death of Jesus in the New Testament. However, they differ in sequence and in details, allowing various understandings of the cross to unfold. Because the death of Jesus was and is such a deeply mysterious and perplexing event, different dimensions are explored and laid bare by different New testament writers. Matthew, Mark, Luke and John all bring forward somehow the resurrection into the story of Jesus' death. None is more

dramatic than Matthew, who introduces not one but two earthquakes at this point.
