PARABLES OF THE HIDDEN TREASURE AND THE PEARL

In today's Gospel, Jesus summarises his message using two further, but much shorter parables. The dream of finding hidden treasure in a field or a great pearl at sea would have been very familiar to the disciples at that time; there were no banks as we know them today, so people buried their valuables to keep them safe or bought pearls which they could secretly carry in their clothing.
