WHEN IN DOUBT.... MUMBLE !



There are two parts of the Mass where people have asked me "should we say this or not?." I call these the mighty mumbles. When Catholics celebrate Mass, the Eucharistic Prayer is in its entirety reserved to the priest and that includes the final Doxology "Through Him, with Him, in

Him etc." The people's assent to the Eucharistic Prayer is the Great Amen. Some priests encouraged people to join in the Doxology. I think it was well meant. If the Doxology and Amen are said, not sung, it's hard for the people to get much emphasis into a single Amen. So I think some priests thought that by having the people say the whole Doxology they could better express their assent to the whole Eucharistic Prayer. It was well intended, but it shouldn't have been done. It caused confusion at Masses where people had come from many different parishes leading to the familiar incomprehensible, uncomfortable mumble.

You may have noticed another confused mumble just before Holy Communion. The prayers of the bishop or priest celebrating Mass have, up to now, been addressed to God the Father, but in this moment, with Our Lord sacramentally present on the altar, it is addressed to God the Son as part of our preparation for Communion. So the priest prays "Lord Jesus Christ, who said to your Apostles: Peace I leave you, my peace I give you, look not on our sins, but on the faith of your Church, and graciously grant her peace and unity in accordance with your will, who live and reign forever and ever". As with the Doxology the people give their assent by responding Amen. Similar to the Doxology, some individual priests encourage people to say all the prayer resulting in another confused mumble. So that's what's happening.
