## Twenty Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

*In today's parable, the offence is to be found in the blindingly obvious answer to the question Jesus sets. The application is then very sharp: those who seemingly never have experienced sin and conversion (who are they?) are quick to judge others who come to God through failure and fracture. Its is like the ninety-nine who have no need of conversion—we may doubt that they ever really existed? A certain complacency can mark any settled religious group and if we add that self righteousness, then the mix is explosive and we are far from the Gospel as preached by Jesus.*
