FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY



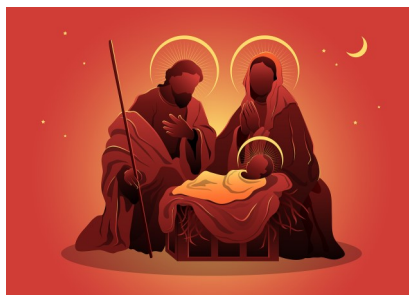
Saturday next, Jan 6th is the Feast of the Epiphany and a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses as follows;

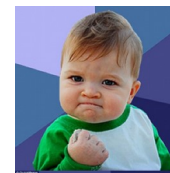
