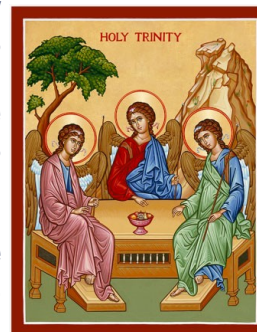
This Sunday, we are invited to reflect on how the Trinity impacts our lives:
