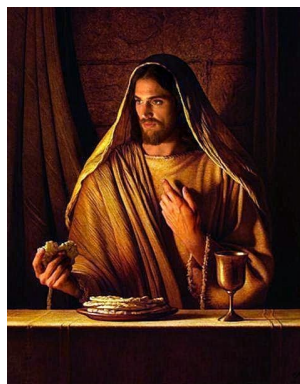

## CORPUS CHRISTI



The Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, or Corpus Christi is a Catholic celebration that focuses on the Eucharist, the belief that Jesus Christ is truly present in the bread and wine consecrated during Mass. It's a time for reflection on the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and the significance of this gift for believers.

**Real Presence of Christ:** The central focus is the belief that the consecrated bread and wine become the actual Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, not just symbols.

**Eucharistic Devotion:** The feast encourages deeper devotion to the Eucharist and practices like Adoration.

**Gratitude and Thanksgiving:** It's a time to thank God for the gift of the Eucharist and the spiritual nourishment it provides.

**Spiritual Nourishment:** The Eucharist is seen as spiritual food that sustains believers in their faith journey.

**Communion and Community:** The feast also emphasizes the communal aspect of the Eucharist, highlighting how it unites believers in Christ.
