Twenty Third Sunday in Ordinary Time



The themes for the Twenty-Third
Sunday in Ordinary Time, Year C,
revolve around the demands of
discipleship, the necessity of having
God's wisdom, and the importance
of detachment from worldly
possessions and relationships to
follow Christ. The Gospel passage
challenges believers to understand
that becoming a disciple requires a radical commitment,
which involves prioritizing God above all else, even
"hate" for one's family and possessions. This call to
radical commitment is further explored in the readings,
which highlight the contrast between limited human
understanding and the boundless wisdom of God.
