LUKE 17:11-19



The readings this weekend centre on **gratitude, faith, and the universality of God's mercy**. In the Gospel, ten lepers are healed, yet only one — a Samaritan, a foreigner — returns to thank Jesus. His gratitude becomes the doorway to deeper faith and salvation. Healing is given to all, but only the thankful heart recognizes the healer.

Naaman's story in the first reading echoes this truth: a foreigner is cleansed of leprosy and proclaims faith in the one true God. God's grace reaches beyond borders, traditions, or status — it is open to all who are humble enough to receive it.

St. Paul, in the second reading, reminds Timothy to remain steadfast: even when we are unfaithful, **God remains faithful**. Gratitude and perseverance, then, are responses to God's unwavering mercy.

We are invited to pause and ask: **Do I truly recognize the gifts God has given me?** Gratitude transforms healing into wholeness and faith into relationship. To thank God is not only polite — it is to acknowledge His presence in our lives.
