

called to be: "salt of the earth" and "light of the world."
Salt only matters when it seasons, and light only matters
when it is shared. Discipleship, then, is never meant to
be hidden or private. Our faith is meant to shape the
world around us.Isaiah reminds us that genuine worship flows into
concrete love—feeding the hungry, caring for the poor,
and lifting burdens from others. When faith becomes
action, God's light breaks forth like the dawn. Saint Paul
echoes this truth, insisting that the power of Christian life
comes not from eloquence or status, but from reliance on
God alone.In ordinary time, our daily routines, workplaces, and
families, Jesus asks us to live visibly Christian lives.
Simple acts of kindness, integrity, and mercy can quietly
glorify God. When we live the Gospel with humility and
love, we help the world see God's goodness shining
