

In the Gospel for today, Jesus meets a Samaritan woman at the well. It is a quiet, ordinary moment, yet it becomes life-changing. This woman carries a complicated and painful story, one that likely left her judged and isolated. Yet Jesus does not avoid her or condemn her. Instead, he speaks to her with respect and compassion.

What is striking is that Jesus sees her completely and still offers her the gift of "living water." He recognises not only her past, but her dignity and her potential.

We all encounter people whose lives are messy or difficult, people who may be easily judged or misunderstood. The Gospel invites us to pause before judging and to see others as Christ sees them with compassion and hope.

Lent reminds us that God meets us in our own broken places. Like the Samaritan woman, we are known and loved by Christ, and from that encounter new life can begin.
