In today's Gospel (John 14:1–12), Jesus speaks words of deep reassurance to troubled hearts: "Do not let your hearts be troubled." He invites us to trust—not only in God, but in Him as the way, the truth, and the life. In a world marked by uncertainty, this promise grounds us in hope. Jesus does not offer vague comfort; He reveals a relationship. To know Him is to know the Father.

Thomas and Philip voice the questions we often carry: "How can we know the way?" and "Show us the Father." Jesus responds by pointing to Himself—His words, His actions, His love—as the living revelation of God.

We are also called beyond comfort into mission. "Whoever believes in me will do the works I do." Our faith must become visible in love, service, and courage. This Easter season, may we trust more deeply, follow more faithfully, and reflect Christ more clearly in our daily lives.
