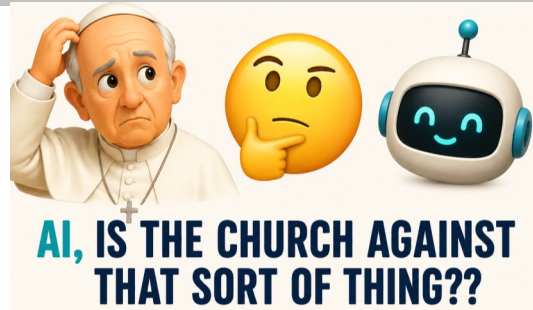

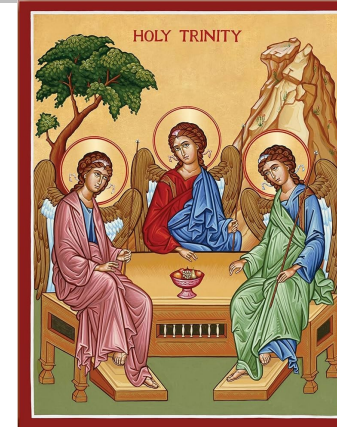

Pope Leo XIV's first encyclical, *Magnifica Humanitas* ("Magnificent Humanity"), examines the opportunities and dangers of artificial intelligence through the lens of Catholic social teaching. Inspired by Pope Leo XIII's *Rerum Novarum*, it presents AI as one of the defining challenges of our age and insists that technology must always serve the human person and the common good. The Pope acknowledges AI's potential to advance education, healthcare, communication, and scientific progress. At the same time, he warns against the concentration of technological power in the hands of a few corporations or governments, the erosion of privacy, job displacement, misinformation, and growing social inequality. He strongly opposes the use of AI in autonomous weapons and calls for the "disarmament" of AI from systems of domination, exclusion, and warfare. A central message of the encyclical is that human dignity, freedom, conscience, and moral responsibility can never be delegated to machines. Pope Leo calls for ethical regulation, international cooperation, transparency, and a renewed commitment to truth, justice, solidarity, and peace. True human greatness, he teaches, is found not in technological power but in love, communion, and openness to God.
