On the surface, the part of the mass we call **THE LITURGY OF THE WORD** may appear like just listening to the stories and reminiscing about the past. To look at it that way, is to miss the point completely.

The importance of the WORD OF GOD is that it is God himself speaking to us, so it is definitely not simply listening to the stories and reminiscing about the past. Neither is it a class in religious or moral truths, but a DIALOGUE between God and his people. This dialogue is carried out in reading and reflection, in attentive listening, and in the response of prayer. For this dialogue between God and his people to occur, the reader's voice is the voice of God! Their ministry, which is to proclaim the WORD OF GOD, to be the voice of God for the assembled community, is therefore a special calling and a unique privilege, carrying with it a great responsibility.

At mass, we are nourished at the **TABLE OF THE WORD** and the **TABLE OF THE EUCHARIST**. As we use a good quality Chalice and Paten to respect the Eucharist, the **WORD OF GOD**, is always read from the sacred book called the LECTIONARY.
