We sincerely thank you for your generous contributions, they are vital in keeping our parish going. As well as during the offertory at mass, contributions can also be dropped into the Parochial House or the "mass card donation boxes" or online using the DONATE button on Kilmaley Parish Website or the IBAN numbers above.

Easter Priests' Collection: Traditionally the Priests' Collection money in a parish was divided between the priests living there. Incomes varied greatly depending on what parish you were in.

Later, a fairer system set a standard salary for priests across the diocese. Parishes which couldn't pay their priests were subsided by parishes with excess funds. You can see from the accounts, there was a shortfall of about €3000 in this parish last year. Parishes with no resident priest still avail of the services of a priest. The four parishes Kilmaley, Mullagh, Miltown Malbay and Inagh are grouped together in the Crioche Callan Pastoral Area which is served by three priests. The plan is to pool all priests' collection money from these four parishes in one account to meet the salaries of the three priests assigned to this Pastoral area. It should ease the burden on individual parishes.
