The feast of the Most Holy or  
Trinity Sunday is celebrated on  
the first Sunday following  
Pentecost in most of the liturgical  
churches in Western Christianity.  
It is a solemn celebration of the  
belief in the revelation of one  
God, yet three divine persons. It  
was not uniquely celebrated in  
the early church, but as with  
many things the advent of new,

sometimes heretical, thinking often gives the Church a  
moment in which to explain and celebrate its own  
traditions; things it already believes and holds dear. In  
the early 4<sup>th</sup> century when the Arian heresy was  
spreading, the early church, prepared an Office of  
Prayer with canticles, responses, a preface, and hymns, to  
be recited on Sundays to proclaim the Holy Trinity.  
Pope John XXII (14<sup>th</sup> century) instituted the celebration  
as a feast for the entire Church; the celebration became  
a solemnity after Vatican II.



In the Diocese we have a safeguarding committee, made up of
