The father, a symbol of God, welcomes him back with open arms, emphasizing grace and forgiveness. The elder son, resentful of this mercy, reminds us of the danger of self-righteousness.

Today, the "lost" could be anyone who feels disconnected from God—those struggling with addiction. homelessness, broken relationships, or a lack of purpose. They may also be individuals consumed by materialism, success, or pride, unaware of their spiritual needs. 
