**JUNE PRIESTS' COLLECTION** is being taken up this  
weekend. This collection is one of six each year which pays  
priest's salaries and supports retired priests through the  
Benevolent Fund. The 2024 priests' collection income came to  
**€28,095**. A priest's salary is €31,360. When our obligations to  
the Benevolent Fund and health insurance are included,  
payments out of the account came to **€43,852**, leaving a  
shortfall of **- €14,666**. Thank you to all of you who contribute  
so generously. For those who don't, perhaps you may wish to  
consider if the services of a priest are important enough to this  
parish to warrant an ongoing financial commitment.
