Twenty Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The themes this week revolve
around wealth and poverty, social
responsibility, and the inevitability of
death. The readings call for a commitment
to justice, challenging indifference to the
plight of the poor and emphasizing that true
wealth lies in compassion and living a life of
active faith, rather than accumulating
possessions.



Wealth and Poverty: The parable of the Rich Man and
Lazarus illustrates the stark contrast between a wealthy
individual who ignored a suffering beggar and the final
reversal in the afterlife.

Indifference and Responsibility: The rich man's lack of
concern for Lazarus highlights a spiritual blindness that
keeps individuals from recognizing and acting on the needs
of others.

Social Justice: The prophet Amos criticizes those who live
in comfort and luxury while the vulnerable suffer, a message
echoed in the need to serve the poor as a reflection of
Christ.

Faith in Action: The readings from Timothy and the Gospel
call for a faith demonstrated through good works, reminding
us that what we do with our lives matters more than what we
possess.

Eternal Judgment: The parable serves as a stark warning
about the consequences of our actions and choices in this
life, particularly our treatment of the poor.
